

# Hoxton Hall

## Entrance

From the street, the main entrance is wheelchair accessible.



## Entry is through this arch

The automatic door will open and you will enter the foyer.



## Foyer

Once inside, the foyer looks like this. There will be someone here from Hackney Shed who will introduce you to the space.



## Corridor

From the foyer, continue down the corridor to access the rest of the space



## The Bar

At the very end of the corridor is the bar. We MAY use this area for breaks and as a quiet space.



## The May Scott Room

Through the bar you come to the May Scott room. It has mirrors along the side which can be hidden from view by black curtains. We will use this area for our workshops.



## Access to other levels

Along the main corridor you will see stairs going up, stairs going down and a lift. The main toilets & art room are in the basement.



## Basement Level



From the stairs or the lift turn left to access the art room.



## Art Room

The art room will be a breakout space or a quiet space for us. The doors on the left of the space open to a small courtyard.



## Toilets

The toilets are on the basement level.



For the gender neutral accessible toilet turn left from the lift/stairs and go to the very end of the corridor (past the art room).

There is another accessible toilet on the second floor.



For the male and female toilets turn right from the stairs/lift and go to the end of the corridor.
